## MARK CRITZ: ALL TALK AND NO ACTION

WASHINGTON, PA –Washington insider Mark Critz launched a new television ad campaign this past weekend that is designed to talk his way through this campaign while avoiding any real commitment on issues.

**Critz Talk:** “I oppose the health care bill.” Fact: Despite being asked by The Hill and other media outlets prior to the vote, Mark Critz refused to state his position on the health care bill. When later questioned by Politico, Critz said he would not vote to repeal Speaker Pelosi’s bill.

**Real Action:** Tim Burns has always been against the health care bill and signed a pledge to repeal it. If Mark Critz is now really opposed to the health care bill, he should sign the Repeal It! pledge instead of tacitly supporting Nancy Pelosi’s big government agenda.

**Critz Talk:** “Mark Critz wants to create jobs right here.” Fact: Mark Critz says his top issue is jobs, but his real record is one of massive job losses – unemployment rose between 76% and 135% on his watch.

**Real Action:** Tim Burns knows how to create jobs – creating 400 new jobs himself. If Mark Critz wants to talk jobs, he should agree to debate Tim Burns on cap-and-trade in front of Southwestern Pennsylvania workers and explain why as a Congressional Staffer he helped pass the job-killing cap-and-trade bill.

**Critz Talk:** “Mark believes that by easing the tax burden on working families and increasing their buying power...” Fact: Mark Critz is quick to attack Tim Burns for being in favor of tax reform while he refuses to sign the Taxpayer Protection Pledge.

**Real Action:** Early in his campaign, Tim Burns signed the Taxpayer Protection Pledge promising to vote against any tax increase.

“There is enough cheap talk in Washington. My campaign is about offering voters real solutions to our country’s problems,” claimed Tim Burns. “Mark Critz, a career government bureaucrat, wants to simply engage in political speak in an effort to deceive voters.”
